




The games are designed for primary school pupils and introduce key concepts of active citizenship, intercultural understanding and life skills through play-based learning. Using storytelling, problem-solving and interactive challenges, children are encouraged to reflect on values such as respect, cooperation, inclusion and democratic participation in a fun and age-appropriate way.

The games can be used:

- in the classroom as part of structured lessons,
- at home with parental support,
- or independently by pupils as complementary learning activities.

By combining learning with play, the iTACKLE games help children develop social and civic competences while staying motivated and engaged.

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The iTACKLE Educational Toolkit: Empowering Young Active Citizens

The iTACKLE Educational Toolkit is a practical, easy-to-use resource designed for primary school educators, parents/guardians and pupils. It supports the development of life skills, intercultural awareness and active citizenship, helping schools promote democratic values in inclusive and engaging ways.

The toolkit is structured into three dedicated modules:

- Educators: ready-to-use lesson plans and classroom strategies for integrating active citizenship and life skills into everyday teaching.
- Parents/guardians: activities that connect school learning with the home environment and support children's social and civic development.
- Pupils: age-appropriate, interactive activities that encourage cooperation, reflection and real-life application.

Each module includes practical activities and simple evaluation tools, supporting both learning and reflection. The toolkit is free, multilingual (EN, FI, EL, IT, RO) and adaptable to different national curricula. An accompanying online course for educators provides additional guidance and examples.
